How do I create a successful application?

We would like to understand who you are as a person, as well as what your values, achievements, and future goals are. Please share the following:

An updated CV in English (maximum two pages), listing your education, all work experience (including part or full-time, paid or unpaid), extracurricular activities and any other achievements and skills that will show your drive and passions.

Your Bachelor's and Master's diplomas and grade transcripts, in English or the original language with English translation if available. In order to qualify the Go with Maersk, you have to have finished your Master's degree by September 1st in the year you are applying for. If you have not received your diploma yet, please attach your most recent transcript.

A motivational letter in English (maximum one page). Please avoid making general statements about yourself, write specifically and to the point. Here we would like to hear your voice. These are some topics to cover in your motivational letter:

“ Why would you like to have a career in global trade?

“ Why would you like to have a career in global trade?

“ What are your short and long term goals?

“ What experiences make you who you are and what will you bring to the programme?

“ What example from your experiences shows your determination or ability to think beyond yourself?

“ Share the last time you constructively challenged status quo.

“ Why did you choose this position and functions as your first Go with Maersk job?

How do I best prepare for the online assessments?

No special preparation is needed. However, please keep these tips in mind:

- You perform the best when you are well rested.
- Make sure that you are focused.
- Use a space where you can work undisturbed by people or the phone.

How do I best come across in the video interview?

Prepare to present yourself in the video interview as if it were in-person and follow these tips:

- Choose a distraction-free environment.
- Dress appropriately and look at the camera.
- Take your time to read about Maersk, our values and the industries we compete in.
- Reflect on why you would like to Go with Maersk.
- Think how you can best present who you are, your passions, achievements and future goals.
- We welcome diversity of background and thought, so most importantly, be yourself.
